Launched in 2019, InnoPower's goal is to make Indiana the best state for minorities to start and grow a business.


Now a year-round movement with a unique focus on innovation, InnoPower works creatively with community stakeholders across all sectors on initiatives that lead to social and economic inclusion.

Projections by the U.S. Census Bureau show that by 2044, Whites will no longer comprise a racial majority in the United States. By then, the majority of our nation will be made up of a kaleidoscope of racial groups, including Blacks, Latinx, Asians, Native Americans and multiracial Americans. Not providing opportunities now for these currently underrepresented communities to grow will be detrimental to our future growth as a nation.

BUILDING A COMMUNITY OF SUPPORT

EXPANDING ACCESS TO CAREERS IN TECH

InnoPower, Rooted School (Rooted), The Indianapolis Recorder, and Eleven Fifty Academy announced a partnership to improve exposure to technology and light up career paths into the tech industry for African Americans. The shared mission is to create opportunities for African Americans, who are underrepresented in tech.

FUNDING FOR LOCAL ENTREPRENEURS

InnoPower teamed up with Indiana Black Expo, Recorder Media Group and Lilly Endowment, Inc. to present the 2020 IBX Power Pitch Competition. In December, 15 finalists competed for \$9,000 in cash prizes. The event was a culmination of Indiana Black Expo's IBX Series to support millennial-led businesses in the Indianapolis metro area.





EMPOWERING MINORITY BUSINESSES

InnoPower and The Indianapolis Recorder partnered with The S.H.E. Event to empower minority businesses in Central Indiana. The S.H.E. Event is a Black-owned organization that leverages technology and e-commerce to provide opportunities for women-owned businesses and vendors to showcase their goods, products, and services.

GOING GLOBAL

InnoPower is working to develop a stronger pipeline of awareness and access to Africa's talent and solutions, especially in the Nigeria and West Africa regions.

Partnerships with The Funding Space, Afrigrants and Ugwumba Leadership Center are providing development opportunities for both African and American entrepreneurs.

Indiana Minority Business Week will focus on four pillars:

EDUCATION

For more than a generation, we have focused on improving the education of poor and minority students. Real gains have been made, but many gaps still exist. To increase the achievement levels of minority and low-income students, we need to focus on what really matters: high standards and visionary school leaders. Our education system is ripe for disruption and innovation.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Entrepreneurship is the key to economic growth for global and local economies. Yet, too many people still face significant, systemic barriers to entrepreneurial opportunity. In a time of changing demographics in the United States, it is important to include diverse communities in all economic development strategies. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

The nature of work is transforming rapidly in our ever-changing world. As community leaders and organizations choose the path forward, it is imperative they rethink deeply held orthodoxies in order to shape a more inclusive future of work. Generating innovative pathways to employment for marginalized populations has never been more critically needed by so many.

GOING GLOBAL

The old narrative of an Africa disconnected from the global economy is fading. A wave of transformation driven by business and modernization is thrusting the continent from the world's margins to the global mainstream. InnoPower is building a stronger pipeline of access to Africa's talent and solutions. In many ways, we should stop thinking about how Africa can be more like us. Rather, we should think about how we can be more like Africa.
